Program Description

The Positive Outcomes Program from Children's Inclusion Support Services, provides behaviour services to licensed child care programs in the City of Ottawa, that have identified children 0 to 6 years of age who are demonstrating challenging behaviours and who do not qualify for CISS.

- Cause damage to the environment.
