

Behaviour Consultation

Children's Inclusion Support Services provides Behaviour Consultation support in collaboration with the Resource Consultants to licensed child care programs for any child eligible for CISS.

Once a behavioural need is identified, the Resource Consultant will determine if other behavioural services are involved and/or whether a referral should be recommended to the family. The Resource Consultant may also request support from the CISS Behaviour Consultant.

The teaching team, with the support from the Resource Consultant, will assess the child care environment and its effect on behavior and collect data to implement the recommended prevention strategies which include, teaching new skills and documenting the child's progress.

The teaching team will be expected to work in collaboration with the Consultant(s) to evaluate the child's progress. The Director is responsible for coordinating meetings with their teaching team in order to support the implementation and sustainability of the strategies provided.

The goal is to consistently implement prevention strategies which ultimately will support all children in the program.
