## **SUMMARY:**

Supports the Early Childhood Educator (RECE) and/or the Assistant ECE in providing nurturing care and developmentally appropriate education to meet the needs of children in a group setting within a safe and healthy environment in cooperation with colleagues in the absence of customary early childhood educators or assistant early childhood educators.

## **KEY OBJECTIVES:**

- To perform duties in accordance with the mission statement and core values of AFCCS and the mandate of Group Child Care Program.
- To support and assist the ECE's and assistant ECE's in providing a high quality child care program in a group setting that meets the diverse needs and promotes optimum physical, social, cognitive and intellectual development of the children in care.

## **DUTIES WILL INCLUDE BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:**

- Meets children's needs for continuance of care, routines and education in the absence of regular caregiver; reassures children as needed; receives instruction from RECE and ECE Assistant to carry out planned activities.
- Implements program plans and helps set up areas for planned activities as directed by RECE or Assistant ECE; provides a welcoming and nurturing environment through displaying affection, acceptance and support of each child; guides and assists children in activities, routines and transition times; teaches appropriate behaviours and skills through modelling, mediating, questioning, demonstrating and reinforcing.

- 3. Observes and ensures the safety of the children at all times and advises RECE or ECE assistant of concerns,
- 4. Attends to physical needs of children; instructs and assists in washing, dressing, toileting, and eating to develop self-help skills; attends to diapering needs; feeds children and ensures special dietary requirements are met; ensures children are clean, dry and dressed appropriately.
- Assists in maintaining a healthy and safe environment; reports accidents/incidents
  to RECE; observes and reports on illness or health conditions; monitors location for
  health and safety hazards.
- 6. Greets parents and children in a positive manner.
- 7. Other related duties as may be assigned by Early Childhood Educator, ECE Assistant or Program Coordinator.
- 8. Works in accordance with Occupational Health and Safety Standards.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Accumulation of at least three months of experience caring for children
- Verbal communication skills (English, French is an asset)
- Negative Police Record Check Vulnerable Sector current in last six (6) months
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR certificate
- Experience working with others in a team environment
- Adequate energy level and ability to meet the physical demands of the job
- The position requires frequent light to medium physical effort (lifting up to 20 kg or 44 lbs) bending, kneeling, crouching
- Must be able to work outdoors for at least two (2) hours per day year including during cold, snow, rain, hot and humid weather
- Sensitivity and respect for individual and cultural differences
- Experience working with children with special needs is an asset
- ECE Diploma or degree from a recognized college or university is an asset
