In this role you will have the ability to manage your work schedule with some flexibility to meet the delivery needs of our providers. Delivery hours will be flexible depending on number of deliveries scheduled and range from a minimum of 5 hours per week up to a maximum of 40 hours per month. The role includes some cleaning, assembly of equipment, and small maintenance or repairs. A vehicle, meeting the needs to transport large equipment, without opportunity for weather damage, is a requirement of this position. Mileage will be covered at 0.50 per kilometer. If you enjoy delivery activities and have an aptitude for repairs and assembly of equipment, this position may be a fit for you.
