This innovative program is designed to intentionally connect children and seniors through daily, meaningful interactions that promote belonging, well-being, and lifelong learning. We are hiring a **Registered Early Childhood Educator (RECE)** for this new and innovative centre.

Opening in May 2026, the Perley Health Intergenerational Child Care Centre will create 49 childcare spaces and accommodate children from infancy through preschool. Conveniently located on the first floor of the Perley Health Centre, the program will intentionally foster daily meaningful interactions and relationship-building between the children and the seniors residing at Perley Health. This model integrates seniors and young children in daily activities for mutual benefit, combating isolation and improving cognitive/social skills for both. The team will engage in specialized professional learning opportunities such as Engage at Every Age Modules; Ageism Awareness Training; Gentle Persuasive Approach; and other relevant training specific to the intergenerational model.
